Participating in the Census is Critical to the Future of West Virginia's Kids and Families



The CountMeInWV Coalition is a statewide grassroots effort with 28+ organizations, associations and individuals working together to ensure every West Virginian *counts* in the upcoming 2020 Census.

Why: Over 440,000 West Virginian live in hard to count communities. This means more than 24% of West Virginia's population is at risk of being undercounted in the 2020 Census. The barriers to completing the 2020 Census - lack of broadband, living in a rural community, mistrust of the Census process.

At stake are several hundred federal financial assistance programs that rely on census data to determine the amount of funds given to states, counties and cities. These programs include the Medical Assistance Program (Medicaid), Medicare Part B, the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Section 8 Project-Based Housing and Head Start/Early Head Start, among others. An undercount in the 2020 census will impact the amount of money the state and counties receive for these programs starting in 2021.

Who: The most likely folks to be undercounted are seniors, families with children under 5 years of age, communities of color, rural residents, college students, grandparents raising grandchildren and immigrant communities.
