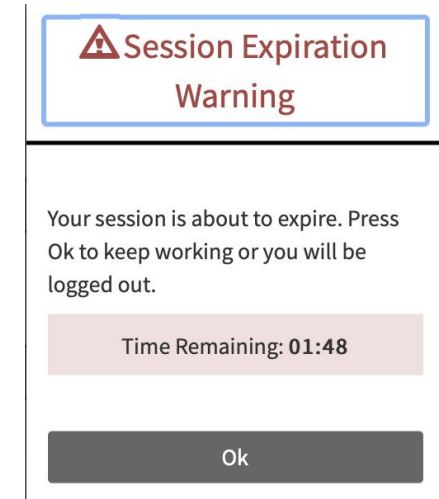
Key Things to Know

Key Things to Know

- Housing units will receive a letter with a **12-digit code**.
 - This code is entered into the ISR to begin filling out the form.
 - If someone does not have a code, no worries, select “...do not have a Census ID...” from the login screen.
- There are **13 languages** available online and the form can be filled out using the corresponding language keyboard. It is not, however, possible to draw characters when filling in your information. ([video guides](#))

Key Things to Know

- The form must be completed in **one sitting**.
 - If there is no activity for 13 minutes, a reminder will pop up to complete the form. 
 - If there is no activity for 15 minutes, the session will end, and the respondent will have to start from the beginning. 



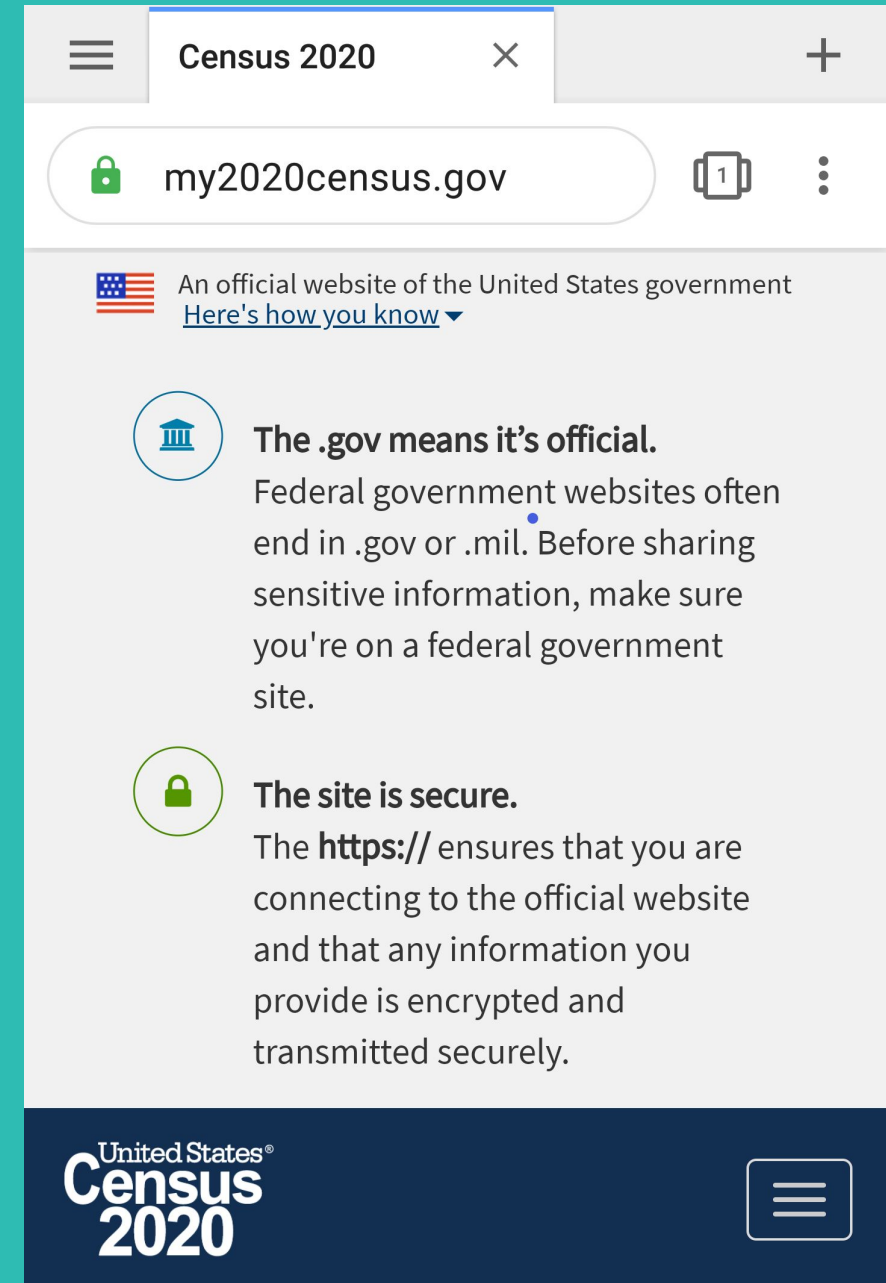

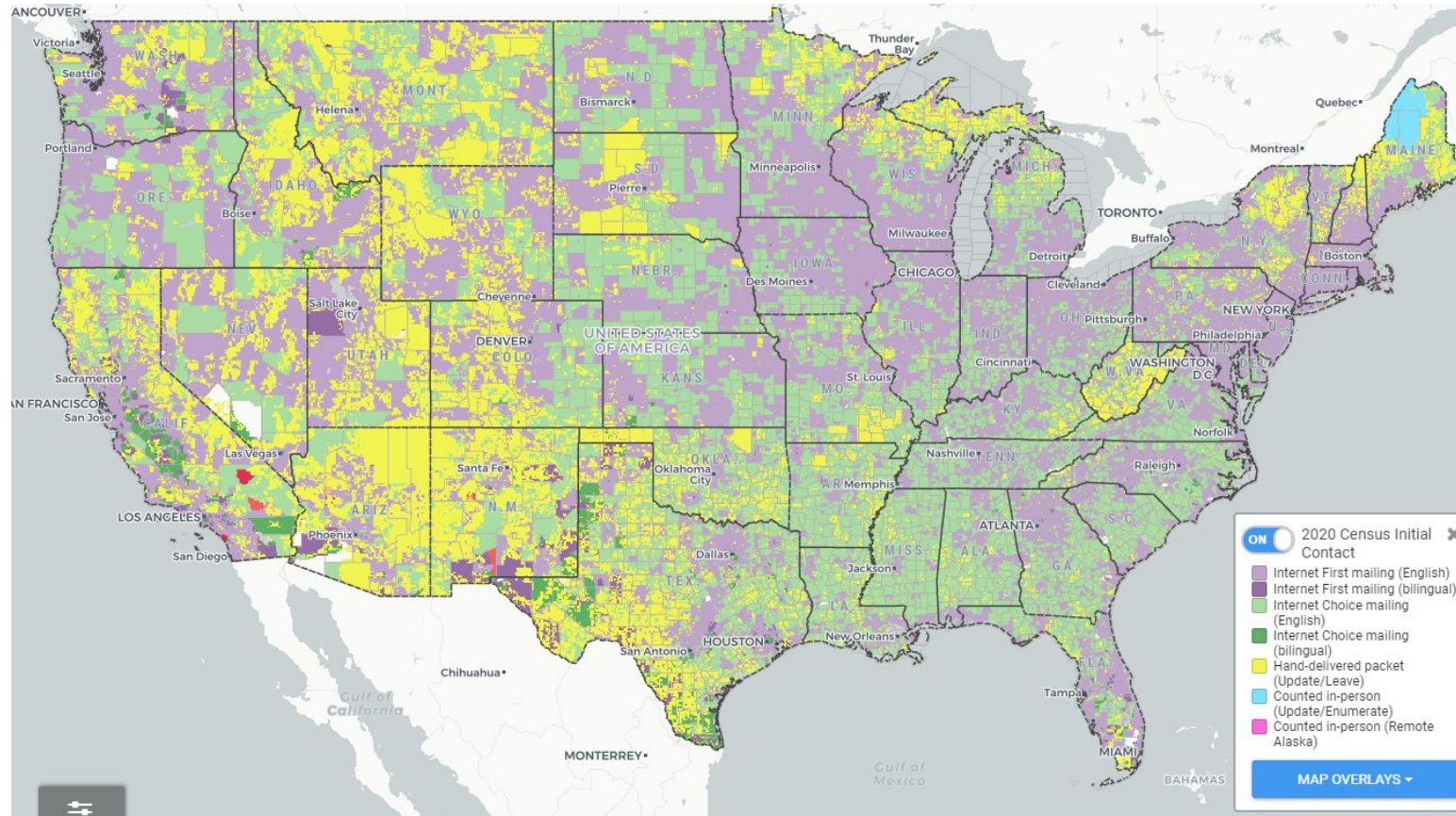

- For people with more than one place to live, count them at the place where they sleep most of the time.

- For people who do not have a usual residence, or who cannot determine a usual residence, count them where they will be staying on April 1, 2020.
