



#### Sample posts:

- Following the 1990 census, Pacific Islander leaders fought for the creation of our own category separated from Asian American category. Let's get our community counted at <a href="https://www.my2020census.gov">www.my2020census.gov</a> #CountUsIn #PasifikaCount #WhoWillWriteMyStory #AAPI2020
- The Census Bureau created the first NHPI Racial Ethnic Advisory Committee (REAC) to inform their work in preparation for Census 2000. It was the first census that had our own NHPI category. - The NHPI population grew 40% between 2000-2010, a rate faster than the total population (10%) and just behind Latinos (43%) and Asians (46%). Let's get counted at my2020census.gov #CountUsIn #PasifikaCount #WhoWillWriteMyStory #AAPI2020
- In the U.S., the NHPI label encompasses at least 20 distinct communities, including larger communities such as Native Hawaiians, Sāmoans, Chamorros, Fijians, Tongans, and smaller communities such as Marshallese, Chuukese, Palauans, and Tahitians, just to name a few. #CountUsIn #PasifikaCount #WhoWillWriteMyStory #AAPI2020
- Did you know? After California, the largest community of Fijian, Samoan, and Tongan Americans are 20,000+ strong in Utah! - Did you know the #2020Census is the only national source of disaggregated data?
   Without this data, the specific needs of our diverse AANHPI communities would be hidden under broad categories and rendered invisible. Get counted at my2020census.gov #CountUsIn #AAPI2020
- Did you know? Redistricting after the 2010 census allowed New York to send its first Asian American to the House of Representatives @RepGraceMeng! A complete count leads to representation, so fill out the #2020census at <a href="www.my2020census.gov">www.my2020census.gov</a> #CountUsIn #AAPI2020
- Did you know? Because of staunch advocacy by Pacific Islander community leaders and Senator Daniel Akaka (Hawai'i), Pacific islanders created their own category on the #Census: "Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander." Get counted my2020census.gov

- Did you know? Language access at polling places is determined by census data. Help your community members who aren't English proficient access their right to vote and fill out the #2020census! Get counted at my2020census.gov #CountUsIn #AAPI2020
- AANHPIs are not a monolith. Together this community is made up of people of nearly 50 ethnicities who speak more than a hundred languages. Fill out the #2020Census to make sure we are all seen and heard! www.my2020census.gov #CountUsIn #AAPI2020

## Day 3 (March 27 at 3pm ET // 12pm PT & throughout the day): EVERYONE in the household should get counted

- Congratulations! If you are a new parent by April 1st, make sure you count your newborn in the #2020Census. Get counted at <a href="https://www.my2020census.gov">www.my2020census.gov</a> #CountUsIn #AAPI2020

#### Sample Posts for College Students

Sample THREAD:

 Tweet 1/2: College students should be counted where they live while attending school, even if you've temporarily relocated due to #COVID-19! If you live off-campus: fill out the #2020census at my2020census.gov (click "Don't have my ID"). #CountUsIn #AAPI2020

Tweet 2/2: If you were living in a dorm before #COVID-19, you will still be counted as part of Group Quarters operations. The Census Bureau is asking universities to contact their students and remind them to respond. www.my2020census.gov #CountUsIn #AAPI2020

#### Sample Post for folks who live in group homes

#### Sample Post about incarcerated folks

The #2020census counts people where they "eat and sleep most of the time," so
incarcerated folks will be counted at the location of their prison, not their residential

#### Sample Post for folks experiencing homelessness


#### Sample Posts for LGBTQ Folks

- #2020census only has male and female options for "sex." Sadly, transgender and GNC folx only have binary options for their sex assigned at birth or how they identify. You'll still be counted if u skip the Q but may be visited by a Census-taker.

- The Census does not ask sexual orientation but it DOES ask about relationships.
   Same-sex married spouses and same-sex unmarried partners can check a box on the Census. We need better LGBTQ representation. For now, let's get counted at <a href="https://www.my2020census.gov">www.my2020census.gov</a> #CountUsIn #AAPI2020
- LGBTQ AAPIs must be counted! Our communities are here and will not be made invisible. Get counted with us at <a href="https://www.my2020census.gov">www.my2020census.gov</a> #CountUsIn #AAPI2020


